hard	solid, firm, note easy to break or bend.	Stiff
soft	not hard or firm, gentle to the touch and easy to fold or cut.	Transpare
rough	not even or smooth (a rough surface will be lumpy or bumpy to touch).	
smooth	not rough or lumpy (you can run your finger over smooth surfaces easily).	
dull	not bright or shiny.	Hard
shiny	bright and reflects light.	Stiff
flexible	bends easily.	Opaque
stretchy	slightly elastic and stretches easily (can be made longer or wider without tearing).	
stiff	firm, not bendy.	
opaque	cannot be seen through.	Hard
transparent	can be seen through.	Stiff Opaque
waterproof	keeps water out.	Shiny
absorbent	soaks up water (or other liquids)
